PTA Founders' Day

Founders' Day, February 17 is when we celebrate the legacy and work of our founders. National PTA works toward bettering the lives of every child in education, health and safety. Founded in 1897 as the National Congress of Mothers by Alice McLellan Birney and Phoebe Apperson Hearst, National PTA is a powerful voice for all children, a relevant resource for families and communities, and a strong advocate for public education. Alice McLellan Birney and Phoebe Apperson Hearst founded the organization when women did not have the right to vote. But they believed mothers would support their mission to eliminate threats that endangered children, and in early 1897, they started a nationwide campaign. In 1970, the National Congress of Parents and Teachers (National PTA) and the National Congress of Colored Parents and Teachers (NCCPT)—founded by Selena Sloan Butler in Atlanta, Ga.—merged to serve all children. As the largest volunteer child advocacy organization in the nation, National PTA is the conscience of the country for children and youth issues. It is that time of year when local PTA/PTSA units elect their Nominating Committee. Nominating Committee members work to seek nominees for the local unit election to be held in April or May. Be sure to include electing a nominating committee on your next general meeting agenda. Here are the bylaws regarding the Nominating Committee.

Section 5. NOMINATING COMMITTEE

- a. There shall be a nominating committee composed of three (3) members who shall be elected by this local PTA/PTSA unit at a regular general membership at least two (2) months prior to the election of officers. The committee shall elect its own chair.
- b. The nominating committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office to be filled and report its nominees at a general membership meeting prior to the election meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the election meeting.
- c. Only those paid members who have given their consent to serve, if elected, shall be nominated for, or elected to an office.




Diversity and Inclusion Award
